



## 11<sup>th</sup> INTERNATIONAL LIVING SCULPTURE COMPETITION "The Mother" Cuneo - Italy 6-14 October 2007

### GENERAL REGULATIONS

- The international Living Sculpture competition is open to **students of both Italian and foreign Fine Arts Academies**
- Participation is free of charge.
- The theme of the competition is "**The Mother**", with demand for plans to environmental development
- The theme may be elaborated through the various sculptural interpretations.
- The application form and the confidential detail treatment form (Art. 13 L.D 196/2003 Privacy code) are to be sent to fax no. 0171 698388 or sent to Promocuneo - Piazza Foro Boario 2 -12100 Cuneo, by **30<sup>st</sup> June 2007**
- By the **31<sup>st</sup> July 2006** the following **MUST** reach the foundation Peano - Corso Francia 47 -12100 Cuneo:
  - three dimensionai model
  - 2 printed photos, or slides or CD of the model on the back of which must be indicated: title of the model, the name of the academy, name of the teacher, personal details of the creator of the model (name, surname, address, phone number).
  - legible report on A4 size paper.
- The models must be sent at the expense of the participant and any models which reach us in a damaged condition will not be assessed or exhibited.
- Participation in the competition automatically authorizes the exhibition of the works with the sole obligation of the indication of the artist's name.
- The sculptures presented will be included in the Catalogue and displayed at the exhibition.
- The winning models will remain the property of the Peano Foundation, that reserves the right to exhibit them.
- Non-classified models can be collected. Any works that are not collected will become the property of the Foundation, that reserves the right to exhibit them.
- The exhibition will be officially opened on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2007, at 6.00 P.M.
- The sculpture which will be classified as being in first place in the 2006 International Living Sculpture competition, with free theme, will be uncovered on 6<sup>th</sup> October 2007, at 5.30 P.M.
- The creators of the winning sculptors will be promptly notified and will be invited to the award ceremony.

### PANEL OF JUDGES:

- The jury will consist of three leading personalities in the art world, a representative of the Town Council of Cuneo and the Chairman of the Peano Foundation.
- The jury will classify three works out of the participating entries and will decide whether to approve of the preparation of the winning entry.

*Should the jury provide its consent, the work must be completed within eight months of the award, using non-consumable material that is not harmful to those using opening spaces. The overall cubic dimensions must be of 5 m<sup>3</sup>.*

*The Peano Foundation will contribute to the funding of the costs involved for the creation of the same, up to a maximum sum of 5000 Euro, and it will remain the property of the same, and will be installed in a green area of the town of Cuneo.*
