GENERAL REGULATIONS

- Art. 1 Peano Foundation International Sculpture Competition is open to Italian and International students of the Academies of the Fine Arts. Participation is free.
- Art. 2 The theme of the 2013 edition of the competition is "Old/New" which can be explored through the various languages of sculpture, in order to submit projects appropriate for outdoor exhibition.
- Art. 3 The application form for the competition must be faxed to: 0039(0)171.603.649; mailed to: Fondazione Peano Corso Francia, 47 12100 Cuneo, Italy or e-mailed to: segreteria@fondazionepeano.it before June 14th, 2013.
- Art. 4 The following items must be received by Peano Foundation before July 19th,
 2013 otherwise the artwork will be excluded from the competition:
 - n° 1 three dimensional model created with a freestyle technique;
 - n° 2 digital colour photographs of the model on a CD, which should include the title of the artwork, the name of the Academy, the name of the tutor and the personal details of the creator of the model (name, surname, postal address, telephone number and e-mail address);
 - a written description of the model: a paper copy and an electronic copy saved in Word format on a CD, which should include the title of the artwork, the name of the Academy, the name of the tutor and the personal details of creator of the model (name, surname, postal address, telephone number and e-mail address). As well as the information regarding the conception of the artwork, the written description must also contain information regarding its realisation and actual dimensions. The above listed items must be sent to: Fondazione Peano Corso Francia, 47 12100 Cuneo, Italy.
- Art. 5 The artwork model will be shipped at the participant's expense. Any damaged models will neither be judged nor displayed.
- Art. 6 Participation in the competition automatically gives to Peano Foundation the authorisation to display and/or publish the artwork. Peano Foundation's only obligation is to cite the artists' names.
 - All the artwork models submitted by the participants will be published in the catalogue and displayed in the exhibition.

- Art. 7 The winning artwork models will remain property of Peano Foundation, which reserves the right to display them at its main office or during exhibitions.
- Art. 8 Non prize-winning models which are not collected before November 30th, 2013 will remain property of Peano Foundation.
- Art. 9 The jury panel will award study grants to the artists of the three winning artworks. The prizes are the following:

1st place: 3,000 Euro 2nd place: 2,000 Euro 3rd place: 1,000 Euro

The artwork winning the competition must be realized by the artist within eight months from winning the competition, using non-perishable materials which are not dangerous for the users of open spaces and must have a cubage of at least $5m^3$.

Peano Foundation will contribute with the sum of 5,000 Euros towards the cost of realization of the artwork which will remain property of the Foundation itself. The economical contribute will be reimbursed to the artist upon receipt of proof of expense. Peano Foundation will indicate a green area of the town of Cuneo in which to place the artwork.

- Art. 10 The jury panel will consist of three personalities from the art world, a representative of the municipal council of Cuneo and the President of the Peano Foundation.
 The jury panel will award three of the participating artworks and will explain the reasons of their decision.
- Art. 11 The artists of the winning artworks, along with their tutors, will be informed
 in advance and invited to the prize-giving ceremony.

The exhibition will be opened on September 21st, 2013 at 6.00 pm.

The winning sculpture of 16th International Sculpture Competition 2012 "The space of youth aggregation" will be unveiled on September 21st, 2013 at 5.00 pm.
